# **Class Descriptions**

## **FRG Essentials**

This class will serve as an introduction into the Family Readiness Group (FRG). Students will review the FRG mission and determine how leaders can advocate mission readiness. A must-have class for FRG Leadership.

## **FRG Key Caller Training**

Designed to prepare volunteers for key caller duties, communicating with Families, and assisting the Command.

## **FRG Treasurer Training**

Critical training for any FRG member who manages the FRG's funds. Learn how to set-up and manage the FRG Informal Fund account in accordance with AR 608-1, Appendix J.

## **FRG Powercourse**

This powerful FRG training course covers all three major FRG trainings - Essentials, Key Caller, and Treasurer, all in a 5 hour block.

## **RDC/CO FRG Training**

Training for Rear Detachment and unit Commanders based on the requirements of AR 608-1, Appendix J, creating an FRG in compliance with Army standards.
