SOAR is an on-line resource for military students. The web site can be found at militaryimpactedschoolsassociation.org.

The web site contains the state standards for every state and tests that focus on those standards. Students will be able to go to the site—whether they are moving or just looking for extra help—take tests to identify their strengths and areas where special attention is needed, and then go to tutorial programs.
